

ORDINANCE NO. 991

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 775 OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs:

Section 1. Incorporation by reference of the Arkansas State Plumbing Law.

(a) Ordinance No. 775 of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, is hereby amended through the incorporation therein by reference of Act 200 of 1951 of the Acts of Arkansas, as amended by Act 372 of 1957, by Act 555 of 1963, by Act 385 of 1973, and by Act 902 of 1975, hereinafter referred to as "the Arkansas State Plumbing Law."

(b) Any person convicted of violating any provision of the Arkansas State Plumbing Law or of the heretofore adopted Arkansas State Plumbing Code, shall be deemed guilty of violating said Ordinance No. 775, as amended by this Ordinance, and shall be subject to fines to be paid to the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, as set forth in Section 7 of said Ordinance No. 775.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 775 otherwise unaffected.

All provisions of said Ordinance No. 775 are hereby declared to be in full force and effect from and after the effective date of this Ordinance and shall be deemed to be coexistent with the provisions of the Arkansas State Plumbing Law and the provisions of the Arkansas State Plumbing Code. Any irreconcilable conflict between any provision of said Ordinance No. 775 and any provision of the Arkansas State Plumbing Law or any provision of the Arkansas State Plumbing Code shall be resolved in favor of the Arkansas State Plumbing Law or in favor of the Arkansas State Plumbing Code, as the case may be.

Section 3. Separability Clause.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend said Ordinance No. 775 in order to more adequately protect the public. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be separable from all other provisions of this Ordinance, separable from the provisions of said Ordinance No. 775, and separable from the

provisions of the Arkansas State Plumbing Law and of the Arkansas State Plumbing Code, and the invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance, ~~or~~ of said Ordinance No. 775, or of the Arkansas State Plumbing Law or of the Arkansas State Plumbing Code, shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance or of said Ordinance No. 775.
