

**RESOLUTION NO. 614**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS AUTHORIZING THE  
MAYOR TO APPLY FOR A GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS  
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION TO HELP FUND CONSTRUCTION OF A  
DOG PARK IN HARMON PARK**

**WHEREAS**, the Eureka Springs City Council has determined that the Eureka Springs Parks and Recreation Commission, a division of the City of Eureka Springs, meets eligibility requirements necessary to apply for a grant under the Arkansas Rural Community Grant Programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Eureka Springs Dog Park Advisory Committee has presented plans for a Dog Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Eureka Springs recognizes the need for the project, concurs with its importance, and supports the Parks and Recreation Commission in its efforts to proceed with the same; and

**WHEREAS**, the Eureka Springs Dog Park Advisory Committee has acknowledged that they must raise \$13,500 through community cash and/or in-kind donations to be applied to the project as a local match;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

The Mayor of Eureka Springs is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Rural Development Commission for purposes of securing state grant funds in the amount of \$13,500 to aid and assist the Eureka Springs Parks and Recreation Commission Dog Park Advisory Committee in executing the proposed project described herein and that the Mayor of Eureka Springs is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same project.
