**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CARROLL COUNTY
AIRPORT COMMISSION WITH DEVELOPMENT OF A
RUNWAY EXTENSION AT THE CARROLL COUNTY AIRPORT**

WHEREAS, the Carroll County Airport, with over 40 based Aircraft, is recognized as a valuable asset to the economic, medical and cultural development of Carroll County, Madison County, Newton County and the Cities of Eureka Springs, Berryville, Green Forest, Alpena, Oak Grove, Holiday Island, Huntsville and Jasper; and,

WHEREAS, the Runway of the Carroll County Airport is three thousand five hundred and fifty five feet in length and seventy five feet wide providing a safe and reliable landing area for approximately 75% of the small aircraft; and,

WHEREAS, runway length is an important factor to determine insurance coverage limits for most small aircraft including jet aircraft; and,


WHEREAS, the Carroll County Airport Commission has determined the need to lengthen the Runway to four thousand feet to accommodate most small aircraft and small jet aircraft.
