

RESOLUTION NO. 630

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CONTINUED USE OF CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY FOR THE PUBLIC DISPLAY OF ART

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, in an effort to promote business for the City; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Eureka Springs Arts Council, which is under the Mayor, is to advocate for the arts, and to encourage, empower, and coordinate a sustainable arts economy through the diverse creative community of artists and arts organizations in Eureka Springs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The Eureka Springs Arts Council is approved to continue to use certain City-owned property for the display of Arts as follows: "The Eureka Springs Art Wall" displays located in the 1st Street parking lot and the "Off the Wall" displays located on 23 North/North Main entrance to town.

Section 2. That said period of use shall be no less than two (2) years from the date of the approval of this Resolution with renewal possible by future resolution.


