

RESOLUTION No. 645

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW HOSPITAL

WHEREAS the City Council of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, having been contacted by those concerned with building a new hospital in Eureka Springs, Arkansas with regard to the availability of adequate sanitary sewer services for said facility; and

WHEREAS extending City sewer services along U.S. Highway 62 to the current proposed site appears to be financially feasible in the near future by the reissuing, refinancing and/or repaying of certain bond obligations now outstanding; and

WHEREAS the extension of City sewer services to the proposed site would be necessary to open a new hospital.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of Eureka Springs does hereby support any legal actions to further the construction of a new hospital within the corporate city limits; and,

Section 2. Does hereby resolve to begin the necessary steps, if financially feasible, to construct the necessary sewer line extension along U. S. Highway 62 when actual construction has begun for the new hospital at the proposed site.
