

**RESOLUTION NO. 648**

**A RESOLUTION TO GRANT A CONSERVATION EASEMENT TO THE  
ARKANSAS HISTORIC PRESERVATION PROGRAM FOR THE HARMON PARK  
TROLLEY BARN OFFICE**

**WHEREAS**, the Eureka Springs Parks and Recreation Commission office building, located at 532 Spring Street, is in need of repair; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Eureka Springs has been awarded a Historic Preservation Restoration Grant from the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program to provide financial assistance to make these repairs; and,

**WHEREAS**, one of the conditions for this financial assistance is the conveyance of a preservation conservation easement on the log building known as the Harmon Park Trolley Barn Office at 532 Spring Street; and,

**WHEREAS**, the preservation conservation easement allows the City of Eureka Springs to retain ownership and possession of this historic landmark while granting the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program the authority to protect the historical and architectural characteristics of the property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:**

**Section 1.** That a preservation conservation easement on the log building known as the Harmon Park Trolley Barn Office and the land immediately surrounding it may be conveyed to the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program.


