**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE USE OF CERTAIN CITY
PROPERTY FOR THE PUBLIC DISPLAY OF STAIR ART**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, desires to promote business for the City; and,

WHEREAS, the mission of the Eureka Springs Arts Council is to advocate for the arts and to encourage, empower, and coordinate a sustainable arts economy through the diverse creative community of artists and arts organizations in Eureka Springs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:**

Section 1. The Eureka Springs Arts Council is approved to use certain City owned property for the display of Art as follows: Stair Art to be painted on the riser portions of the City stairs extending from Spring Street to Main Street along the building edge located at 19 Spring Street.

Section 2. The said period of use shall be no less than three (3) years with renewal possible by future resolution.

Section 3. The Eureka Springs Arts Council is hereby authorized to develop guidelines, rules and regulations with regard to said displays as necessary.


