

RESOLUTION NO. 628

LAKE LEATHERWOOD CITY PARK ADA COMPLIANT BATHHOUSE

WHEREAS, the City of Eureka Springs has determined that the Eureka Springs Community meets eligibility requirements necessary to apply for a grant under the GIF Funded Community Enhancement Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Eureka Springs Community has presented plans to build a new bathhouse in the style of the existing Civilian Conservation Corp building. The new building will be completely ADA accessible and have the ability to be used year-round and allow the old building to be repurposed as a nature education center in accordance with the Lake Leatherwood City Park Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Eureka Springs recognizes the need for the project, concurs with its importance, and supports the Eureka Springs Community in its efforts to proceed with the same

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor of Eureka Springs is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Rural Development Commission for purposes of securing state grant funds in the amount of \$150,000 to aid and assist the Eureka Springs Community in executing the proposed project described herein.

Section 2. The Mayor of Eureka Springs is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same project.
